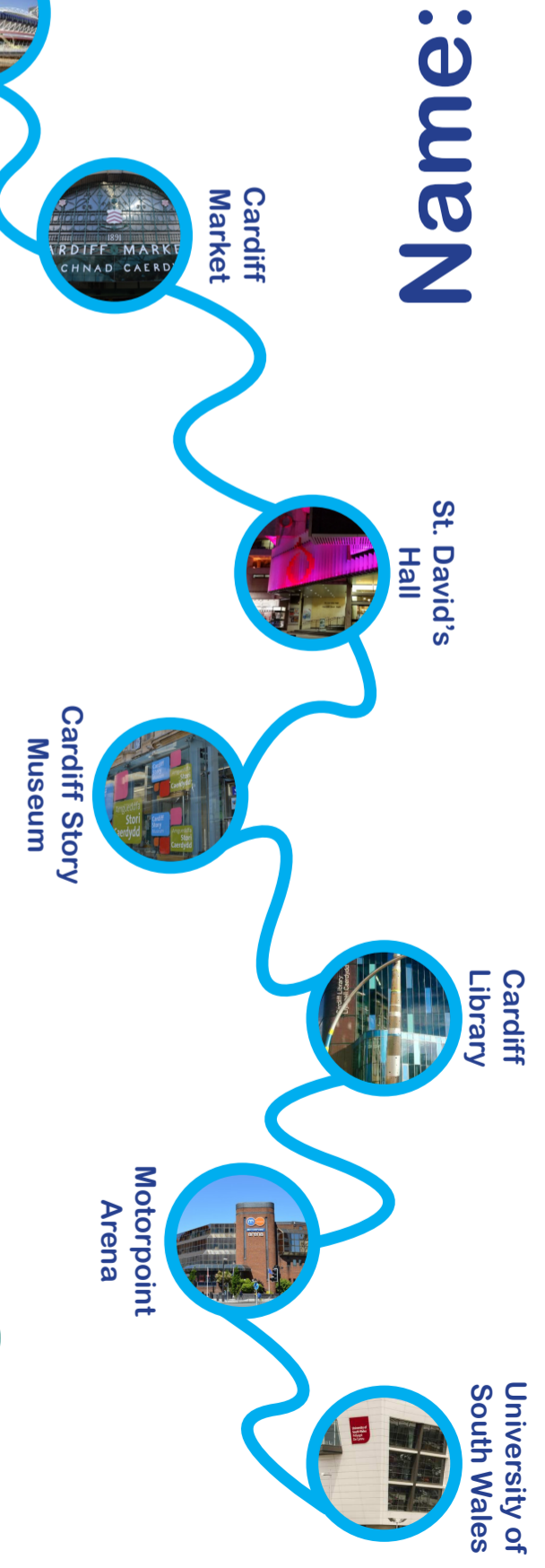
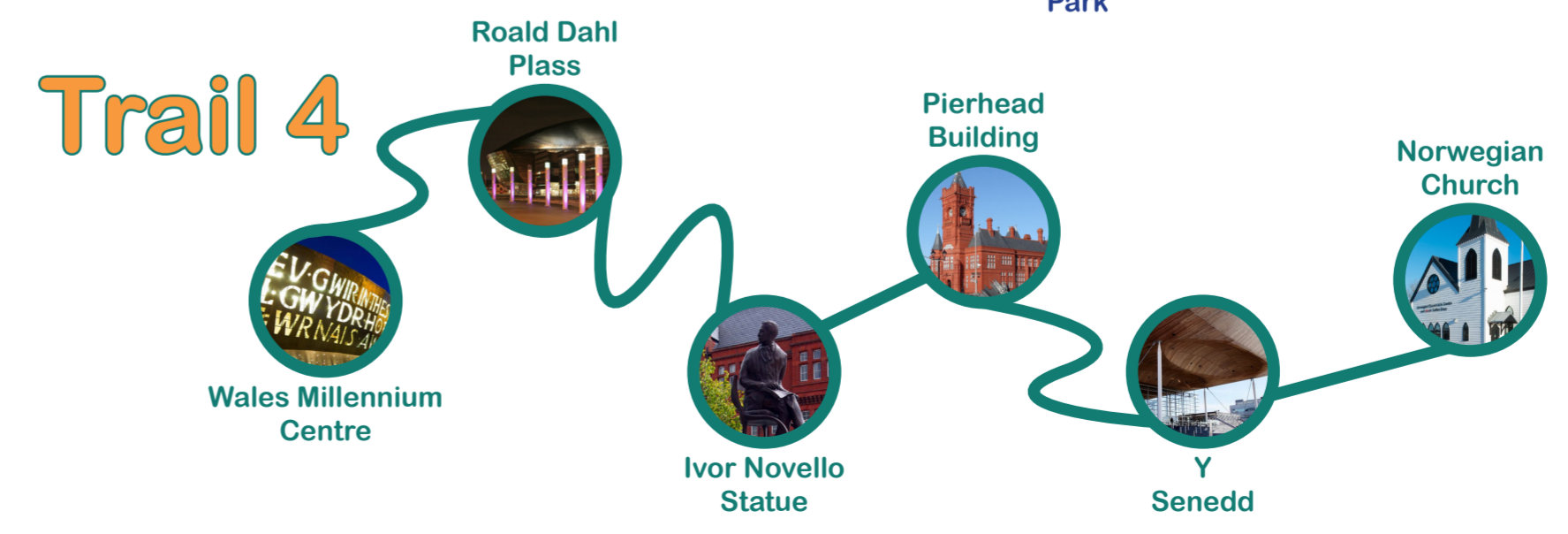
The Willows Way
