


Welcome Back!

Return to School:

We are looking forward to welcoming Year 10 back for the whole of next week and catching up with our other learners on the dates below. If you have any questions about this, please e-mail your child's Welfare Officer in the first instance who will be able to answer all queries:

- Year 10 will return to school on Monday 22nd March for the last week of term.
- Year 7 will attend school on Tuesday 23rd March for a Check in-day.
- Year 8 will attend school on Wednesday 24th March for a Check in-day.
- Year 9 will attend school on Thursday 25th March for a Check-in day.

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A reminder that from the 22nd March we will need to return to timings that include split lunches and breaks throughout the day so that the instances where Year Groups in school come into contact with each other are minimised. We will ensure that teachers communicate this with pupils and set their online lessons accordingly for pupils to access at the correct times.

When pupils return they will be **expected to wear school uniform**. This recommendation is contained in the Welsh Government operational guidance. Please contact your child's Welfare Officer if you foresee any problems with this. **On days where pupils have PE, they will continue to wear their PE kit to school** (as before Christmas) until further notice. Pupils will need to wear face coverings in the classroom where physical distancing cannot be maintained. The school will provide two face coverings to every pupil on their return. However, pupils may wish to carry their previous school face-coverings (black) in their bags in case they want to swap them during the day.

Staff and pupils in Y11 have been provided with Lateral Flow Tests which detect Covid-19. Y10 will also receive these on their return to school. The tests should be performed on a Sunday and Wednesday evening by following the instructions provided. It is vitally important for parents to inform school of any positive results and to keep their household at home for ten days to protect our community. If you require assistance with the instructions, please contact your child's Welfare Officer who will be happy to help.




Thank you, as always, for your support with our online learning and our return to school plan. By working together, we are sure that we can make this run as smoothly as possible for our children.


