#### **Happy New Year!**

Blwyddyn Newydd Dda to all members of our Willows community! We hope you enjoyed a peaceful and relaxing break. It has been a pleasure to see our pupils return to school happy and ready to learn. We look forward to working with you, once again, to achieve the best outcomes for your child.

#### **Health and Well-being:**

We understand that there may be some anxiety surrounding covid transmission in schools but please be assured that we are working firmly within Welsh Government guidelines to minimise risk. Please continue to help us with the following:

Mask / Face Coverings: All pupils and members of staff are required to wear a face covering in all areas of the school building and on school transport, unless they are medically exempt. This means all pupils MUST bring a mask / face covering to school each day and wear it appropriately. Face coverings have been supplied to all pupils but if your child requires a new one, please make sure their form tutor is aware.

Hand Sanitising: Pupils will be asked to sanitise their hands regularly, especially in the school canteen. Please

continue to explain the importance of hygiene to your child.

Lateral Flow Tests: We kindly ask all students to take three lateral flow tests every week. The tests should be taken on Mon / Wed / Fri morning each week. The tests can be easily picked up, free of charge, from most pharmacies or several outlets around Cardiff or you can order online for home delivery. We will also distribute testing kits as and when we are supplied with them. If a member of your household tests positive, then other members of the same household may continue to attend school if they have a negative test. However, they should undertake daily testing (for 7 days) using the LFD tests provided.

Canteen: Year groups will continue to have separate breaks and lunches to minimise risks.

Fresh air: All classrooms will have open windows / doors in order to ensure a fresh flow of air through the building. Pupils will be allowed to wear coats in class depending on temperature and conditions.

**Communication:** In order to minimise disruption and to keep infection rates as low as possible, we kindly ask you to remain vigilant, to test regularly and keep your child at home if he/she receives a positive test or has Covid symptoms. As always, you can contact us by e-mail or phone to inform us of any absence.

Currently we do not envisage a return to distance learning, however we will clearly face challenges and will keep you informed of any changes to this.


